Check your answers with those below. For answers with more than one possibility, give yourself points from within the range provided. When you have finished, add up your total points.

If your answer is very similar to the sample answers, give yourself 3 points; if you used 'visto' but forgot the 'me,' give yourself only 2 points; if you used the right verb but in the wrong form, give yourself only 2 points; if you answered the question but didn't use any verb at all, give yourself only 1 point; if you didn't know how to answer the question or your answer was not related to the question, give yourself 0 points.

2. "Sí, fui el domingo con mi padre y mi hermana." or "No, no fui al centro comercial." If your answer is very similar to the sample answers, give yourself 3 points; if you did not start the sentence with 'sí' or 'no,' give yourself 2 points; if you used the right verb but in the wrong form, give yourself 2 points; if you answered the questions but didn't use any verb at all, give yourself 1 point; if you didn't know how to answer the question or your answer was not related to the question, give yourself 0 points.

3. "Aprendimos gramática y vocabulario." or "Aprendimos a construir una máquina." or "No aprendimos nada." If your answer is very similar to the sample answers, give yourself 3 points; if you used the right verb but in the wrong form, give yourself 2 points; if you answered the question but didn't use any verb at all, give yourself 1 point; if you didn't know how to answer the question or your answer was not related to the question, give yourself 0 points.

4. "Tocaba el piano." or "Tocaba el saxófono." or "No tocaba ningún instrumento musical."
