

AP Test Site Security Regulations 2009

To provide the best possible test taking environment it is important that all students comply with the security regulations below. Non-compliance may result in cancellation of individual and/or group scores. **Please review the following before test day.**

Students should bring with them:

- #2 pencils
- Black or blue ballpoint pens
- Calculator (Calculus, Statistics, Chemistry, Physics exams only)
 - A maximum of two calculators are allowed, extra batteries are encouraged.
 - Approved models: T1-85, T1-86, T1-89 and T1-84 Plus
 - For an up to date list of approved calculators go to www.collegeboard.com/ap/calculators
- A sweater or sweatshirt if needed for varying room temperature.
- Water (must be a clear water bottle with no label)

Students SHOULD NOT bring with them:

- Cell phones, PDAs, MP3 players, IPODs, or any other electronic or communication devices
- Books, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes or scratch paper
- Bags, backpacks, purses or any personal belongings
- Food
- Clothing with subject related information

Behavior & Conduct Expectations

- Upon check-in, please find a seat immediately.
- Remain seated at all times until permission is given to leave the room for break or dismissal.
- Instructions of the proctor must be followed. Students interfering with the administration of the examinations will be expelled from the session, with no refund.

- Morning exams

 - Testing begins at **8:00 a.m.**
- Afternoon exams
 - Check-in begins at: **12:15 p.m.**,
 - We will begin filling in the answer sheet promptly at: **12:30 p.m.**
 - Testing begins at: **1:00 p.m.**
- Dismissal

Students will be dismissed at the end of the exam, after collection of **all** materials. Students are not allowed

to leave before the end of the test administration.
